Emperor Goose Non-Resident Drawing Permit Hunt



We provide Emperor Goose and Sea Duck hunts on Kodiak Island, Unit 8. We hunt from our Kodiak private property on Ugak Bay, a short 20-minute flight southwest from the city of Kodiak. Season dates: October 8 - January 22.

Emperor Goose: Nonresident hunters are able to participate in the Emperor Goose hunt if selected for an Alaska draw permit (Hunt number: DO508).

How to Apply:

1. Review current Alaska Drawing Permit Hunt Supplement on ADF&G website: <https://www.adfg.alaska.gov>.
2. ADF&G online Draw Permit Applications are accepted: **Nov 1 - Dec 15, 5:00pm (AKST)** for the following year's hunting season.
3. Purchase Alaska nonresident hunting license. ADF&G requires the applicant at the time they apply for their draw permits to purchase an Alaska nonresident hunting license.
 - Alaska nonresident small game hunting license for \$60.00 or
 - Alaska nonresident big game hunting license for \$160.00
 - Draw permit entry fees for each hunt choice are \$5 each, maximum of six choices.The license fees and entry fees are nonrefundable.
4. In the same ADF&G online Store Purchase page click on **Drawing Permit Hunts**. In the area under draw choices, you may apply as Individual or Party (two hunters).
5. Under species, choose Emperor Goose hunt number: **DO508**.

Hunters should review the Alaska Migratory Game Bird Hunting Regulations, including Federal and State duck stamp requirements.

Draw Results will be announced online (ADF&G website) by the third Friday of February.
