## Fishing Gear List

Here's some suggested fishing gear to bring.

### Gear List and License:

- Alaska Sport Fishing License and King Stamp obtained at <https://www.adfg.alaska.gov/Store/>.
- Waterproof day pack for carrying gear.
- Bring your favorite Fly Rod (6-9 wt). floating line with weight tip or Spinning Rod.

### Layering System:

- 1-set of Travel clothes.
- Helly Hanson Rain Coat with hood (knee length) and pants.
- Warm Jacket and windproof (Polar Fleece or Wool).
- 4-pair Shorts, base layer.
- 2-pair Long Underwear, polypro, base layer (Medium Weight).
- 4-pair Socks, liner.
- 4-pair Socks, Wool or Polypro (Medium Weight).
- 3-pair Undershirts, base layer.
- 2-pair Pants (at least one quick dry).
- 3-pair Shirts, long sleeve various weights.
- Vest (Wool, Fleece, or Holo-fill).
- Ball cap.
- Fleece or wool hat or stocking cap.
- 2-Pair Gloves (1 Polypro, 1 Neoprene).

### Footwear:

- Chest or Waist lightweight stocking foot waders: Simms, Cabela's, & Orvis. Or, Hip Boots.
- Wading boots (no studded boots). Boots go over stocking foot waders. Simms, Cabela's, & Orvis.
- Muck Wetland rubber boots for Saltwater fishing and beach combing.
- Slip on shoes or crocks for lodge.

### Optics:

- Camera with extra batteries, charger, and Scan Disk memory cards.
- Binoculars (for Whale watching and Wildlife viewing).
- GPS Port for downloading photos.
- Waterproof bag for cameras and optics.

### Personal:

- Toiletries (tooth brush, comb, medication, etc.).
- Sunscreen lotion.
- Towel.
- Chap stick.
- Polarized sun glasses.
- Extra Pair Prescription Glasses or Contacts.
- Insect repellent (Deet) and head net.

**Other:**

- Knife and leatherman.
- Flashlight.
- Water bottle.
- 2-large Plastic bags for dirty clothes and boots.
- iPhone with extra back-up battery.

**Weather:**

During the summer months, (June, July, August, and September) the low temperatures rarely dips below 40 degrees and the high temperatures may reach the mid-70's. Average temperature is 55 degrees.
